Gender-based Violence Facts

Violence against women is a gross human rights violation, yet it continues at an unabated rate. Despite South Africa’s progressive laws, there appear to be little or no consequences for the perpetrators of such violence.

- Every day three women die at the hands of their intimate partner. That’s one every eight hours.
- South Africa has a femicide (a woman killed by her intimate partner) rate five times higher than the global average.
- It is estimated that at least 45% of women have been physically or sexually abused by an intimate or non-intimate partner
- “Corrective rape” in certain parts of South Africa continues where lesbians are raped with the aim of converting them to heterosexuality.
- A total of 275 536 applications for protection orders were processed by the Department of Justice in 2015/2016.
- A total of 1018 child homicides were recorded across the country in 2009 alone, with 454 being fatal child abuse cases.
